BIO Adana **Mam Legros**



Adana, a captivating French-Cambodian artist and artivist, intertwines the realms of art expression, psychological exploration, and her poignant life experiences with a fervent dedication to social activism.

Her artistic journey took flight with a mesmerizing debut exhibition in New York back in 2019, paving the way for an impressive series of 17 international showcases. Not only does Adana exhibit her art globally, but she also orchestrates exhibitions with a noble cause at heart – donating proceeds to local NGOs. One remarkable event raised a staggering \$150,000 in support of a psycho-social non-profit organization.

Adana's artistic prowess has garnered the admiration of notable figures like Academy Award winner Susan Sarandon, Hollywood star Annalynne McCord, renowned American composer Chloe Flower, and Cambodian-American songstress Laura Mam. Most recently, her evocative paintings found a new home in the collection of esteemed individuals such as the director of private sales at Hong Kong Sotheby's and the esteemed business magnate behind Rosewood Hotel Cambodia, Mr. Vattanac.

ART

As she grappled with the harsh reality of cancer at just 21, navigating the relentless trials of chemotherapy, an artist emerged within her. Bound to a bed of suffering, she discovered a sanctuary where her spirit thrived, finding healing through artistic expression.


Adana's art is a captivating fusion of surrealism and naïve art, where nude, earthy-toned bodies with golden halos tell tales of both suffering and resilience. These ethereal creations pay homage to the untold stories of exploited women who surrounded her earlier in life. In her recent works, Adana unveils self-portraits enveloped by Cambodian motifs, serving as a reminder of her roots and a heartfelt yearning to reconnect with her ancestral lineage. Immersed in vibrant landscapes teeming with exotic blooms and lush foliage, she resurrects childhood memories, finding solace in nature.

(Through her artistry, she navigates an identity crisis, seeking a sense of belonging amidst the intricate tapestry of two intertwined cultural heritages marked by tumultuous histories – from the era of the French protectorate to the shadows cast by Western involvement in the Khmer Rouge genocide.)

Following an intensive 3-and-a-half-year psychoanalytic journey delving into the depths of her subconscious, Adana's art emerges as a powerful exploration for self-discovery. Art plays a central role in her quest for individuation, providing a valuable space for exploration and reflection on her own self and the surrounding world. Each brushstroke is used as an efficient tool of symbolization, inviting unexpected messages to surface on her canvas. Drawing parallels with Winnicott's theories on early mother-child relationships, Adana's creations embody a transitional space where profound emotions and experiences converge in a harmonious dance of creative expression offering a deep introspection.











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
